## Hydrangea Fest Tea Party - July 16








# **Summer Kayaking!**

Volunteers can help for 1-3 days. Food and Accommodations are provided to volunteers who come for 2-3 days. Food is provided for those helping for 1 day too.


The bike trek starts and finishes at Camp Burgess, 75 Stowe Road in Sandwich, MA each day.





























There was a lot of fun and games, but also some Club official business at the Annual Picnic and Meeting on June 29.
